

FLAMING QUEST (GB)



Legacy of champion, top sire Rainbow Quest lives on in Texas stallion Flaming Quest (GB)

The racing and breeding world lost champion and top sire Rainbow Quest when the 26-year-old died in England in 2007, but Texas can lay claim to one of the stallion's two sons now standing in the U.S., **Flaming Quest (GB)**. A stakes-placed multiple winner by the English and French champion, Flaming Quest has five crops of racing age, led by Texas-bred Flamefinder, a seven-time winner with earnings of more than \$137,000. Flaming Quest is out of the Sadler's Wells mare Nearctic Flame (Ire), a full sister to multiple Group 1 winner Salsabil (Ire). The 13-year-old stallion stands as property of Charlotte Voss at her Double Star Stable in Leonard.

Rainbow Quest sired more than 100 stakes winners - an impressive 10.5% of his foals - and the earners of approximately \$50 million, including Grade/Group 1 winners Fiji (GB), Saumarez (GB) and Sunshack (GB). Rainbow Quest is now a Chef-de-Race sire.
